Documents Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Detailed valued inventory in French, signed and dated by the shipper ➤ Letter of transfer from the shipper's employer ➤ "Attestation reservation de cale
Customs Regulations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Household goods are duty-free if shipper can prove ownership of those goods
Motor Vehicles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ New autos are dutiable.
Pets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Health Certificate from veterinarian is required.
Dutiable / Restricted Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Home computers are not accepted as personal effects and will be subject to customs duties and import taxes. ➤ New electrical items are subject to payment of customs duties and taxes. ➤ All electrical items and furniture must be more than six months old (invoices required).
Prohibited Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Weapons ➤ Drugs ➤ Alcohol and other spirits are prohibited and should be sent separately.
