<b>Diplomats Removals</b>	➤ Exemption certificate from Government.		
<b>Wedding Trousseaux</b>		Subject to payment of duties.	To be valued by Customs.
<b>Inheritances</b>		Subject to payment of duties.	To be valued by Customs.
<b>New Furniture and Household Goods</b>	➤ Commercial Invoices	Subject to payment of duties.	
<b>Antiques</b>	➤ Certificate of Antiquity	Subject to payment of duties.	
<b>Precious Metal Objects</b>		Subject to payment of duties.	Counterfeit coins prohibited.
<b>Electrical Appliances</b>	➤ Same as removal goods	Subject to payment of duties.	To be valued by Customs.
<b>Motor Vehicles</b>		Subject to payment of duties.	Size and age restrictions apply. Check with local Transport board.
<b>Alcohol</b>		Subject to payment of duties.	No volume restrictions.
<b>Arms and Ammunition</b>			Not allowed.
<b>Medicine, Narcotics, Drugs</b>		Duty free.	Prescription only.
<b>Plants</b>		Subject to payment of duties.	Plants will have to be inspected by Dept. of Agriculture & Fisheries.
