<i>Customs Regulations</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Import of household good and personal effects is permitted into French Guiana. ➤ Customs must have a certificate of change of residence or certificate of transfer or the shipper will have to pay the Octroi de Mer (between 12% and 22% of the CAF value).
<i>Documents Required</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Packing List ✓ Copy of valid passport ✓ Original bill of lading (no express release accepted) / AW3 ✓ Original inventory in French dated, valued and signed by the shipper ✓ Certificate of change of residence or certificate of transfer ✓ Non sale certificate ✓ Certificate of property
<i>Motor Vehicles</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Original registration card ✓ Certified statement of the vehicle ✓ Certificate of insurance ✓ Non sale certificate <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Without any certificate of change of residence and registration card, the Octroi de Mer (22%) of the CAF value has to be paid before the delivery.
<i>Pets</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Certificate of vaccination ➤ No quarantine in French Guiana
<i>Prohibited Items</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Firearms, ammunitions are submitted to authorization from territorial administration. It is very rare to get it. ➤ Unlawful drugs
