Customs Regulations	<ul> <li>Import of household good and personal effects is permitted into French Guiana.</li> <li>Customs must have a certificate of change of residence or certificate of transfer or the shipper will have to pay the Octroi de Mer (between 12% and 22% of the CAF value).</li> </ul>
Documents Required	<ul> <li>✓ Packing List</li> <li>✓ Copy of valid passport</li> <li>✓ Original bill of lading (no express release accepted) / AW3</li> <li>✓ Original inventory in French dated, valued and signed by the shipper</li> <li>✓ Certificate of change of residence or certificate of transfer</li> <li>✓ Non sale certificate</li> <li>✓ Certificate of property</li> </ul>
Motor Vehicles	<ul> <li>✓ Original registration card</li> <li>✓ Certified statement of the vehicle</li> <li>✓ Certificate of insurance</li> <li>✓ Non sale certificate</li> <li>■ Without any certificate of change of residence and registration card, the Octroi de Mer (22%) of the CAF value has to be paid before the delivery.</li> </ul>
Pets	➤ Certificate of vaccination ➤ No quarantine in French Guiana
Prohibited Items	<ul> <li>Firearms, ammunitions are submitted to authorization from territorial administration. It is very rare to get it.</li> <li>Unlawful drugs</li> </ul>
