Customs Regulations	<p>The following are the requirements for import of household goods and personal effects into Guam:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Household goods and personal effects must have been owned for a minimum of 3 months prior to import. ➤ Household goods and personal effects will be cleared by U.S. Customs in Guam. ➤ Any Inventory/Packing List that is written in a foreign language must have an English translation
Documents Required	<p>The following documents are required for import of household goods and personal effects into Guam:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Clear copy of Passport ✓ An original Inventory/Packing List and two clear and legible copies showing items including carton number and contents of each carton ✓ Original Ocean Bill of Lading or an express release copy of the Ocean Bill of Lading if the shipment is originating outside the United States ✓ Pre-forma invoice in U.S. dollars
Prohibited Items	<p>The following items are prohibited from import into Guam:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Narcotics and drugs ➤ Firearms (unless registered with Government of Guam) ➤ Switchblades or knives ➤ Pornography ➤ All food stuffs ➤ Pirated branded articles ➤ Cosmetics ➤ Fireworks ➤ Dangerous toys ➤ Toxic and poisonous substances ➤ Endangered species (artifacts) ➤ Liquor
