<b>Documents Required</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Visa</li> <li>➤ Letter of transfer from the shipper's employer</li> <li>➤ "Attestation reservation de cale"</li> <li>➤ Inventory in French, detailed, valued and signed and dated by the shipper</li> <li>➤ Insurance Certificate</li> <li>➤ International Certificate of Vaccination</li> </ul>
<b>Motor Vehicles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Duties are applicable on new cars</li> <li>▪ RTL (Redevance sur Traitement de Liquidation) tax applies</li> </ul> <p>Documents required for new or used autos:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Original Commercial Invoice</li> <li>✓ Insurance Certificate</li> <li>✓ Value Certificate</li> <li>✓ Document stating vehicle engine capacity</li> </ul>
<b>Dutiable / Restricted Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Tobacco products</li> <li>➤ New electrical items are subject to Customs duties and import taxes</li> <li>➤ Invoices of all electrical items and furniture must be more than six months old</li> <li>➤ Home computers are not accepted as personal effects and will be subject to Customs duties and import taxes</li> </ul>
<b>Prohibited Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Alcohol and distilling equipment are prohibited and should be sent separately</li> <li>➤ Weapons, ammunition and military equipment</li> <li>➤ Drugs and narcotics</li> <li>➤ Printed matter and audio/video materials</li> <li>➤ Food</li> <li>➤ Matches and poisonous substances</li> </ul>
