<p>Documents needed for the Customs Clearance of Household Goods</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Packing list in French ➤ Copy of valid passport ➤ Certificate of change of residence / moving certificate ➤ Original rated bill of lading (no express release accepted) / AWB ➤ Original inventory in French date, valued and signed by the shipper ➤ Invoices for the electrical and hi-fi appliances; and for all the items bought less than 6 months before the shipment's arrival ➤ Residence or work permit or letter from the employer explaining that the client is starting a new contract ➤ Non sale certificate (declaration stating that the shipper will not sell his / her HHG) ➤ Insurance certificate ➤ Bordereau de Suivi de Cargaison (BSC) / Cargo Tracking note. <p>Customs Regulations</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Used HHG's are duty free if they have been in the owner's possession and utilization for at least 6 months. Please note that they must not have any new wrappings on them. They must be used. ▪ Customs only allow 1 fridge, 1 cooker, 1 deep freeze, 1 computer, 1 TV, 1 VCR...per shipper and his / her family, any additional ones will be taxed. ▪ Satellite dishes are considered to be luxury items and are therefore taxed by customs. ▪ Washing products / detergents enough for one month only are permitted. ▪ Please note that almost all the removal shipments are opened and checked by customs
