

Haiti <i>Customs Information</i>	
<i>Documents Required</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Commercial Invoice (Consularized original and one copy)</li> <li>✓ Inventory (original and one copy)</li> <li>✓ Passport</li> <li>✓ Visa (if not a Haitian citizen)</li> <li>✓ Residence Permit (Permis de Sejour) only required if Customer or employer has a tax free agreement with Haitian Government</li> </ul>
<i>Customs Regulations</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Inspection is thorough.</li> <li>▪ <b>Drug laws</b> are strictly enforced.</li> <li>▪ Import limitations (duty free) are as follows:               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ <b>Currency:</b> No Restriction</li> <li>➢ <b>Liquor:</b> One quart bottle or spirits</li> <li>➢ <b>Tobacco:</b> 200 cigarettes or 50 cigars</li> <li>➢ <b>Fire arms (guns and ammunitions):</b> prior written authorization must be obtained from Haiti Army Chief of Staff</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ There are no export limitations.</li> </ul>
<i>Motor Vehicles</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Customs clearance may be lengthy.</li> </ul>
<i>Pets</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Dogs and cats must be properly vaccinated.</li> <li>➢ Veterinarian's certificate of good health and immunization is required for each pet and is only valid within 60 days of issue.</li> </ul>
