

<b>Honduras</b> <i>Customs Information</i>	
<b>Prohibited and Restricted Goods</b>	<p><b>IMPORTS:</b> Weapons, drugs, explosives, pornographic and subversive films and literature. Sporting firearms and ammunition may be imported with a special permit from the Secretary of Defence and the Treasure Department.</p> <p><b>EXPORTS:</b> Legitimate archaeological or colonial relics, precious and semi-precious stones, metals and wood in its natural state.</p>
<b>Household Goods</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Diplomatic personnel, members of international organisations and Hondurans returning after 12 months abroad are eligible to a free import permit or Franchise (Dispensa). This franchise must be secured by client, through a lawyer after arrival, but shipment may be held at customs or S.I.T. in bond, with extra charge.</li> <li>➤ If no franchise or resident permit is available, client will have to secure at customs a very high guarantee, as all articles would be assessed.</li> <li>➤ A customs inspection is mandatory and is usually performed at customs site; however, it may also take place at client's residence for his/her convenience or at agent's warehouse for an extra fee. (Please contact your OMNI agent for details).</li> </ul> <p><b>REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Bill of Lading/AWB</li> <li>✓ Valid passport of the owner</li> <li>✓ Inventory list in Spanish (no other language accepted), three copies.</li> </ul>
<b>Vehicles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ New or used vehicles are heavily taxed and are duty free for diplomats and members of international organisations only.</li> </ul> <p><b>REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Original title of ownership</li> <li>✓ Original purchase invoice</li> <li>✓ OBL, and client's personal documents</li> </ul>
<b>Live Animal and Plants</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ May be imported into the country.</li> <li>➤ A health or quarantine certificate is required.</li> </ul> <p><b>Please note:</b> Clients should mail all necessary instructions and documents at least two weeks in advance to the OMNI agent to secure a rapid customs clearance, otherwise extra charges and demurrage may incur.</p>
