

<b>Iceland</b> <i>Customs Information</i>	
<b>Documents Required</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Work Permit</li> <li>✓ Inventory (in English)</li> </ul>
<b>Customs Regulations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ CUSTOMER MUST BE PRESENT AT CUSTOMS CLEARANCE.</li> <li>➤ Household goods and personal effects may be imported duty-free for non-residents.</li> <li>➤ Items must be for customer's own use not for sale, and must be re-exported at the time of customer's departure from Iceland</li> </ul>
<b>Motor Vehicles</b>	<p>Autos may be imported, but must be re-exported when the owner's stay in Iceland is over</p> <p>Documents required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Vehicle Registration Book</li> <li>✓ International Motor Insurance</li> <li>✓ Owner's Green Card</li> <li>✓ Driver's license valid in Iceland</li> </ul>
<b>Pets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Are prohibited.</li> </ul>
<b>Dutiable / Restricted Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Alcohol and tobacco products</li> <li>➤ Fishing equipment, including waders and rubber boots, which have been used abroad, unless such equipment has been disinfected. A certificate of disinfection issued by an authorized veterinary officer will be acceptable.</li> <li>➤ Electronic equipment (only one of each allowed)</li> <li>➤ Musical instruments</li> <li>➤ Books, video and audio cassettes and movies are subject to censorship</li> </ul>
<b>Prohibited Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Narcotics and poisons</li> <li>➤ Medicines (except small quantities for personal use)</li> <li>➤ Firearms, weapons and ammunition</li> <li>➤ Uncooked meat, meat and poultry products and dairy products</li> <li>➤ Live animals and birds</li> </ul>
