

Japan	Customs Regulations 2011
<i>Household Goods and Personal Effects</i>	<p>Used personal effects are not dutiable in Japan.</p> <p>To clear customs we require:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ clear copy of passport (bio-data page, Japan visa page and last entry stamp page ➤ Original Japan Customs Form (C#5360) which is obtained on aircraft when arriving in Japan and must be stamped by Customs on arrival at airport.
<i>Prohibited and Restricted Goods</i>	<p>Goods prohibited from entering Japan include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ firearms, ➤ ammunition, ➤ pornographic material, ➤ satellite dishes, ➤ short wave radios, ➤ narcotics, or ➤ “subversive literature or materials”.
<i>Motor Vehicles (Autos and Motorbikes)</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Used vehicles must be modified to meet Japanese emission control laws before they can be used. ▪ New cars will be dutiable.
<i>Animals and Pets</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Most pets, including dogs, cats, and birds, can be brought into Japan will be subject a 14 day quarantine period. ▪ The documents necessary at the time of import are a current health certificate (not more than 7 days old) and a current vaccination card. A copy of these documents must be scanned or faxed to JVK at least 10 days prior to arrival. <p>The shipper must be in Japan at the time of clearance.</p>
