Import Regulations on Household Goods and Personal Effects Shipments	<p>A foreigner may import household goods and personal effects into Laos duty free under the following conditions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ He or she has diplomatic status or works for a registered foreign company. ➢ He or she obtains a letter from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs verifying his/her diplomatic status or, in the case of a non-diplomat, obtains a valid Lao work permit. Copies of the employer's investment license and business license will also be required for non-diplomats. <p>If the above criteria are met, only one sea and one air shipment are permitted duty free, and the shipper can only import one each of any electrical appliance duty free.</p> <p>All other foreigners who do not meet the above criteria may import household goods and personal effects into Laos, but they will be subject to duty. The duty amount varies and is often subject to negotiation with the customs department. JVK will work with the shipper and his/her company to minimize any duty liability.</p> <p>While the shipper does not have to be physically present at the port or airport during customs clearance, we must present his/her original passport and original work permit (or diplomatic certificate) to the Laos Customs Authorities at the time of clearance. Thus, the shipper must be in Laos for the shipment to clear through customs.</p> <p>As sea shipments first enter Thailand before being transported in-bond to Laos, please ensure that the bill of lading shows "In-transit to Vientiane, Laos via Bangkok, Thailand". If you send a full container load, please use liftvans. The Steamship lines do not permit their containers to enter Laos, so the shipment must be unstuffed in Bangkok port prior to moving inbond through Thailand and eventually into Laos. Again, please use liftvans.</p>
Prohibited and Restricted Goods	<p>Goods prohibited from entering Laos include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ firearms ➢ ammunition ➢ pornographic ➢ material ➢ "reactionary" publications.
Motor Vehicles (Autos and Motorbikes)	<p>Only a foreign diplomat may import a vehicle into Laos duty free. He or she must obtain a letter from the Laos Ministry of Foreign Affairs verifying his/her status and requesting that Laos Customs permit duty free import.</p> <p>For all other foreigners and returning Lao nationals, it is almost impossible to import a vehicle into Laos. The procedures for a non-diplomat to import a vehicle are time consuming and tedious. The duty assessed can be as high as 300% of the new purchase value of the vehicle.</p>
Animals and Pets	<p>Most pets, including dogs, cats, and birds, can be brought into Laos with no quarantine period.</p> <p>The documents necessary at the time of import are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➢ a current health certificate (not more than 7 days old) ➢ a current vaccination card
Consignment Instructions	<p>Consign both sea and air shipments to: Shipper (name spelt exactly as in passport) C/o his or her company name and Address in Laos</p>
