Customs Regulations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ HOLDERS OF RESIDENCE CARDS MAY BRING IN USED HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS DUTY-FREE IF IN CUSTOMER'S POSSESSION FOR AT LEAST SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO MOVE.
Motor Vehicles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Permitted duty-free if the car has been in owner's possession and used for at least six months and owner is transferring residence to Luxembourg <p>Documents required (in addition to above):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Original Title ✓ Insurance Certificate covering the previous six months ✓ Certificate of Residence
Pets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Dogs and cats permitted with recent Health Certificate. ➤ Medical examination may be required on arrival. ➤ Regulations are often changing; consult the Consulate for specific details.
Dutiable / Restricted Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Alcoholic beverages ➤ New furniture
Prohibited Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Firearms ➤ Drugs ➤ Ammunition ➤ Articles derived from endangered species such as ivory
