DOCUMENTS NEEDED FOR DUTY FREE IMPORT AND EXPORT OF HOUSEHOLD EFFECTS

Important: All documents have to be written in English on company letterhead and should be signed and stamped.

NOTE: - Due to the constant political and economic changes in Eastern Europe, customs requirements are always subject to change.

Import of Personal Vehicles:

Diplomatic Status:

- Protocol from Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
- **Original** of car papers, i.e.: purchase bill, registration, certificate of ownership, license etc.
- EUR 3 is obligatory to import and register the car.

Non diplomatic and returning citizen:

- **Original** of car papers, i.e.: purchase bill, registration, certificate of ownership, license etc.
- EUR 3 is obligatory to import and register the car.
- Custom duty, VAT and taxes must be paid:
 - VAT 18%, Duty 8-10%, Special car tax, from 150 to 6.000 EURO (depend from cm3).
