<b>Documents Required</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Residence or Work Permit</li> <li>✓ Form 21 (Bill of Entry) which needs signed only</li> <li>✓ Passengers Baggage Declaration (Form 47) or Settler's Declaration (Form P 54) depending on size of shipment</li> <li>✓ Inventory (giving serial numbers for TVs and VCRs)</li> </ul>
<b>Customs Regulations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ CUSTOMER MUST BE IN COUNTRY AT TIME OF CUSTOMS CLEARANCE</li> <li>▪ USED HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL EFFECTS DUTY-FREE IF:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Arriving within six months of Customer</li> <li>✓ Were owned by Customer for a minimum of six months and are for Customer's own use</li> <li>✓ Goods are not sold or disposed of while in Malawi</li> <li>✓ Are in reasonable quantities</li> </ul> </li> <li>▪ Shipments may be inspected</li> </ul>
<b>Motor Vehicles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Value may not exceed K500.</li> <li>➤ One auto per family.</li> <li>➤ Auto must have been owned and used by Customer for a year or more prior to importation or arrival of the Customer and can not be lent or sold within one year of Customs clearance</li> </ul>
<b>Pets</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Import Permit obtained from the Veterinary Department is required</li> <li>✓ Copies of Vaccination Certificates</li> </ul>
<b>Dutiable / Restricted Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Items owned less than six months</li> <li>➤ Books/magazines subject to censorship</li> </ul>
<b>Prohibited Goods</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Firearms are subject to Police Permit</li> <li>➤ Ammunition</li> <li>➤ Radio equipment</li> <li>➤ Pornographic material</li> <li>➤ Plants/seeds</li> </ul>
