<i>Documents Required</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Visa</li> <li>✓ Letter of transfer from shipper's employer</li> <li>✓ "Attestation reservation de cale"</li> <li>✓ Inventory in French, valued, detailed, and dated and signed by the shipper</li> <li>✓ International Vaccination Certificate</li> </ul>
<i>Motor Vehicles</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ New cars are dutiable.</li> <li>➤ Import license for new cars.</li> </ul>
<i>Pets</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Health Certificate from veterinarian required.</li> </ul>
<i>Dutiable / Restricted Items</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Home computers are not accepted as personal effects and are subject to duties and import taxes.</li> <li>➤ New electrical items are subject to payment of Customs duties and taxes.</li> <li>➤ Invoices of all electrical items and furniture must be more than six months old.</li> </ul>
<i>Prohibited Goods</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Alcohol and other spirits are prohibited and should be sent separately</li> <li>➤ Weapons (Certificate required)</li> <li>➤ Drugs</li> <li>➤ Books, films and pictures may be subject to censorship and will be confiscated if found to be contrary to local customs</li> </ul>
