Documents Required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Passport (must show last entry stamp) ✓ Visa ✓ Work Permit ✓ Certificate of Change of Residence ✓ "Attestation reservation de cale" ✓ Bank Guarantee ✓ Inventory (detailed in French, valued, dated, and signed by customer) ✓ Importers Declaration for Customs ✓ Health Certificate, showing that the customer has been vaccinated against yellow fever (compulsory) and cholera (optional) ✓ Letter of transfer from customer's employer
Customs Regulations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ CUSTOMER MUST BE PRESENT AT CUSTOMS CLEARANCE. ➤ All shipments inspected.
Motor Vehicles	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ New cars are dutiable. <p>Documents required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ Original Purchase Invoice ✓ Log Book/Registration Card ✓ International Insurance ✓ Valid passport
Pets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Health Certificate signed and dated by a veterinarian, showing that the animal has been vaccinated against rabies.
Dutiable / Restricted Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ All goods less than six months in owner's possession are dutiable (invoices required) ➤ Home computers ➤ Art objects, jewelry and antiques (depends on quantity) ➤ Customer must pay a 5% statistical tax on the declared value of inventory unless customer belongs to an exempted organization or project in Niger.
Prohibited Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Alcoholic beverages ➤ Weapons ➤ Radio equipment ➤ Drugs
