

<b>Portugal</b> <i>Customs Information</i>	
<b>Prohibited and Restricted Goods</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Ammunition, drugs, Gold in bars</li> </ul> <p><b>Dutiable Items:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All brand new items, alcoholic beverages (taxes and VAT applies), foodstuff (theoretically an import licence has to be required before arrival of shipment, duties and taxes apply)</li> </ul>
<b>Useful Information</b>	<p><b>ALL SHIPMENTS</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Shipping instructions and shipper's contact address/phone nr./e-mail should be in the shipper's possession prior to shipment's arrival, no removal should be forwarded before they confirm all documents for customs are available and in order.</li> <li>➤ Storage/demurrage charges at airport/port/terminal are PROHIBITIVE.</li> </ul>
<b>Customs Regulations</b>	<p><b>Shipments originating from member state of European union:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ <b>By truck:</b> Packing list and CMR.</li> <li>➤ <b>By air:</b> Packing list and photocopy of passport.</li> <li>➤ <b>By sea:</b> Packing list, photocopy of passport, OB/L and T2L.</li> </ul> <p><b>Shipments originating outside of the European union to be exempt of duties and taxes (used HHG):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ "Certificado de bagagem" issued by the nearest Portuguese Consulate at origin with a non-evaluated list preferably written in Portuguese.</li> <li>✓ "Certificado de residencia" – Residence certificate also issued by the Portuguese Consulate proving that client has lived in the country of origin of goods at least during the last 12 months prior to his departure to Portugal.</li> <li>✓ EEC declaration supplied by your shipper.</li> <li>✓ Declaration supplied by your shipper where date of arrival and other details are stated.</li> <li>✓ Domicile certificate (atestado de resid?ncia) to be obtained by the client and issued by the Junta de Freguesia in which client's residence in Portugal is situated and stating exact date since which client has been residing there (less than one year).</li> <li>✓ Photocopies of main pages of passport legalized by a Portuguese Notary Public or by any other Portuguese entity entitled to legalize photocopies (Juntas de Freguesia, Post Offices).</li> <li>✓ Photocopy of "Cart?o de Contribuinte" (tax card) or form with the "tax number" also legalized by one of the above entities (original may be required).</li> </ul>
<b>Motor Cars</b>	<p>Docs required ONLY to take the car out of port:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Original registration certificate of vehicle,</li> <li>✓ Certificate issued by the Portuguese Consulate specifically for the car proving that owner, has lived at origin at least during 24 months and that he is cancelling his residence there,</li> <li>✓ Photocopies passport and of Portuguese tax card legalized in Portugal, form to be signed by the owner and provided by us.</li> </ul> <p style="margin-left: 20px;">▪ Vehicle must have been in owner's possession at country of origin for at least six months before arrival of owner in Portugal.</p> <p><b>SHIPMENTS FOR PORTUGUESE DIPLOMATS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ All documents as above except document under domicile certificate</li> </ul> <p><b>SHIPMENTS FOR FOREIGN DIPLOMATS:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Diplomatic franchise to be requested by shipper to the local embassy.</li> </ul>
