<b>Documents Required</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Passport</li> <li>✓ Work Permit (Non-Resident)</li> <li>✓ Customs Bond</li> <li>✓ Inventory (in English)</li> <li>✓ Cash Deposit</li> <li>✓ Import License</li> <li>✓ Proof of overseas residence for minimum one year</li> </ul>
<b>Customs Regulations</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ CUSTOMER MUST BE PRESENT AT CLEARANCE.</li> <li>➤ Used household goods duty-free if owned minimum one year (receipts and other documents required to show period of ownership).</li> <li>➤ Shipments must arrive within two months of Customer.</li> <li>➤ All shipments inspected at Container Examination Station.</li> <li>➤ A 10% special tax applicable to returning nationals that qualify</li> </ul>
<b>Motor Vehicles</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Subject to duty, VAT and tax</li> <li>➤ Import License and proof of ownership required</li> <li>➤ May not sell or transfer vehicle within a period of two years after importation</li> <li>➤ Customer must have owned vehicle for a minimum of six months prior to return to Trinidad &amp; Tobago</li> <li>➤ Customer must have resided abroad for a minimum of five years</li> <li>➤ Invoices (for proof of age)</li> </ul>
<b>Dutiable / Restricted Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ New items (less than one year old)</li> <li>➤ MUST STATE AGE AND SPECIFIC DETAILS FOR ABOVE</li> </ul>
<b>Prohibited Items</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Weapons and ammunition</li> <li>➤ Narcotics and medicine</li> <li>➤ CB radios, walkie-talkies, etc.(will be confiscated)</li> <li>➤ Tapes</li> </ul>
