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| <b>Regulations on Household Goods and Personal Effects Shipments in Turkmenistan</b> |   |
| <b>Import of Household Goods</b>   | <p><b>Diplomats importing HHG and personal effects need the following documents:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Pro-Forma invoice with stated value for customs purposes</li> <li>➢ Packing list</li> <li>➢ AWB / BL / CMR</li> <li>➢ Letter from the Embassy</li> <li>➢ Diplomatic card and/or (diplomatic) passport</li> </ul> <p><b>Individuals other than diplomats and TM citizens are to pay duties 10 USD and need the following documents:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Pro-forma invoice with stated value for customs purposes</li> <li>➢ Packing list</li> <li>➢ AWB / BL / CMR</li> <li>➢ Power of Attorney for AES/Move One to import the shipment</li> <li>➢ Copy of passport with the possibility that the original must be shown</li> <li>➢ Letter from the company</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ The number of brand new goods must not be more than 5 for each kind of goods.</li> <li>▪ A commercial invoice is needed if commercial goods are being brought into Turkmenistan.</li> <li>▪ If there is a personal vehicle with the HHG then it should be a different procedure in customs.</li> </ul> <p>Import customs clearance takes 1 day if all papers are ready.</p> |
| <b>Export of Household Goods</b>   | <p><b>Diplomats exporting goods from Turkmenistan need the following documents:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Packing list</li> <li>➢ Copy of passport</li> <li>➢ Diplomatic card (dip passport)</li> <li>➢ Power of Attorney</li> <li>➢ Letter from organization</li> </ul> <p><b>Foreigners, other than diplomats wishing to export goods from Turkmenistan do not need to be present for the export clearance process. The following documents are needed:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Packing list</li> <li>➢ Copy of passport</li> <li>➢ Power of Attorney</li> <li>➢ Letter from the company</li> </ul> <p>Export customs clearance takes 1 day if all papers are ready.</p>  |
| <b>Prohibited Items</b>  | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Weapons of all kinds and spare parts.</li> <li>➢ Pornography.</li> <li>➢ Narcotics</li> <li>➢ Toxic material</li> <li>➢ Radioactive material</li> <li>➢ Export of antiques, such as carpets, paintings, books, icons or any other items which is considered to be of cultural and historical value.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Import of Pets</b>  | <p><b>There is no restriction on what pets can be imported into Turkmenistan:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Veterinarian certificate (it includes the history of vaccinations).</li> <li>➢ Copy of owner's passport</li> <li>➢ Power of Attorney for AES/Move One employee to handle the customs clearance</li> </ul>  |
| <b>Export of Pets</b>  | <p><b>Documents needed to export a pet from TM are:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Veterinarian certificate issued by Turkmen veterinarians (with the history of vaccinations)</li> <li>➢ Copy of owner's passport</li> <li>➢ Power of Attorney for AES/Move One employee to handle the export</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Import of Vehicles</b>  | <p>Documents needed for temporarily import are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Customs Border Report</li> <li>➢ Invoice or statement about vehicle's value</li> <li>➢ CMR (if vehicle comes on truck)</li> <li>➢ Technical passport</li> <li>➢ Statement by owner on company letterhead stating place of residence in Kyrgyzstan</li> <li>➢ Copy of ID card</li> </ul> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ For all other cars being imported, they can be subjected to duties and taxes on them.</li> <li>▪ The amount will depend on the characteristics of the automobile</li> </ul>   |

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| <b>Import of Vehicles</b><br><i>(continuation)</i>  | Documents needed for import are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Customs declaration from the border</li> <li>➢ Invoice of the car</li> <li>➢ Technical passport</li> </ul>   |   |  |
| <b>Export of Vehicles</b>   | When exporting a vehicle from Turkmenistan, the following documents are needed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Power of Attorney for AES/Move One to handle the export</li> <li>➢ Pro-forma invoice stating the value of the car</li> <li>➢ Import customs declaration</li> <li>➢ Technical passport</li> <li>➢ Copy of Owner's passport</li> </ul>  |   |  |
| <b>Special Instructions for Importing Carpets, Paintings, Musical Instruments, Art Effects &amp; Antiques</b>     | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ When importing jewelry, art antiques and carpets, these items must be registered upon arrival into Turkmenistan. There are no restrictions on what can be brought into Turkmenistan as long as the item is registered and a document from the Ministry of Culture of Turkmenistan must be obtained to show the presence of the item in Turkmenistan.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ When exporting such items from Turkmenistan, those registered upon arrival have no restrictions and do not need any export permits. Other items that were bought in Turkmenistan need to be shown to the Ministry of Culture of Turkmenistan to decide if the item is valuable to Turkmenistan.</li> <li>➢ If the item is permitted to leave Turkmenistan and export permit must be obtained.</li> <li>➢ Antiques are defined on a case by case basis and the final decision is made by Ministry of Culture. It takes 4-5 days to obtain an export permit.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>Important:</b> Valued inventory list for items intended for temporary import should be descriptive, e.g. double bed set, wardrobe, dining table with six chairs and etc. Home electrical and electronic appliances should be very clearly mentioned along with their serial numbers. It is also suggested to declare low value for items for temporary import.</p> <p><b>Note:</b> Valued inventory lists are for customs purposes and therefore the value does not have to be the same as used for insurance purposes. However, it is strictly advised not to enclose the list used for insurance purposes along with the shipping documents.</p>  |   |  |
| <b>Imports of Wines and Spirits</b>   | The <b>allowance limit</b> for the import of wine and spirits for personal consumption is: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➢ Alcohol: 2 1 litter bottles</li> <li>➢ Cigarettes: 10 boxes per person</li> </ul> <p><b>For amounts exceeding the permitted limit, there are duties and taxes on alcohol and tobacco.</b></p>  |   |  |
