| <b>Removal Goods</b>       | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 2 clear negotiable original B/L or a clear copy of the AWB.</li> <li>➤ The consignee passport (NO COPY).</li> <li>➤ Detailed and valued list of contents in English (show serial numbers for electrical appliances).</li> <li>➤ Work permit or appropriate exemption papers (not necessary for returning National's).</li> <li>➤ A copy of the customs documents from origin.</li> <li>➤ Tax Identification Number</li> <li>➤ Copy of employment contract in Uganda (not applicable to diplomats) OR copy of expired employment contract abroad in the case of returning citizens.</li> </ul> | <p>No excise or import duties, provided goods are imported within six months of first arrival.</p> <p>Returning National must have lived abroad for at least 2 years. Only one shipment by sea and air free of duties per person.</p> <p>Imports are subject to 100% verification by Customs.</p>  | <p>Original B/L required.<br/>Express release will cause delays and incur added costs.</p> <p>Work permit is not required for the first air shipment imported within six months of first arrival.</p> <p>New items or multiple items (i.e. two TV's, two fridges, two stereo's) will be subject to import tax and duties of approximately 46%.</p> <p>Duties of 119% will be levied on more than 1 litre of Alcohol.</p> |
| <b>Vehicle, Motorbikes</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ 2 clear negotiable original B/L.</li> <li>➤ Work permit or appropriate exemption papers (not necessary for returning National's).</li> <li>➤ The consignee passport (NO COPY).</li> <li>➤ An invoice or valuation for the vehicle.</li> <li>➤ The original logbook or registration documents and the export documents from the country of origin.</li> <li>➤ The Consignee's Tax Identification Number (TIN).</li> <li>➤ De-registration certificates/ export certificates</li> <li>➤ Road-worthiness certificate</li> <li>➤ An Interpol report confirming ownership</li> </ul>               | <p>No excise or import duties, provided vehicle has been owned by the consignee for more than 12 months at the date the vehicle is exported, is imported within 6 months of first arrival.</p> <p>Only one vehicle allowed free of duties and taxes per person.</p> <p>TIN can be obtained by the consignee 's representative.</p> <p>The destination agent prior to the release of the vehicle from the ICD must complete Licensing and registration of the vehicle.</p> <p>20% Environmental tax is levied on all vehicle aged 10yrs +</p> | <p>The Road worthiness certificate can be obtained in Uganda at approximately USD 150.00</p>   |
| <b>Diplomatic Goods</b>    | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The consignee passport (copies allowed).</li> <li>➤ Permission to import free of duties and verification (exemption letter).</li> <li>➤ Tax identification number (TIN).</li> </ul>   | <p>Exemption letter and TIN are obtained by the local Diplomatic mission from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs.</p>   | <p>MFA permission is normally granted within ten working days.</p>   |
| <b>Pets</b>                | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ The consignee passport (copies allowed).</li> <li>➤ The vaccination book/card.</li> <li>➤ A valid health certificate.</li> <li>➤ Interstate movement permit.</li> </ul>   | <p>Interstate movement permit from the Ministry of Agriculture, Animal Industry and Fishery will be requested to the Commissioner of Livestock in Entebbe airport.</p>   | <p>Permission is normally granted within three working days and is valid for ten days.</p>   |
